# From Greg in Montague Gardens Branch

Here we are already in the 3<sup>rd</sup> month of the year and we ask ourselves where has time gone? We are seeing a lot of changes in our industry with among others the closure of the mine of Serina Kaolin in Noordhoek.

This branch will be moving into our new premises in Racing Park towards the third quarter of the year if all goes according to plan. Our new street address will be corner of McLaren & Cosworth Roads in Racing Park. Exact dates and new telephone/ fax numbers will be advertised well in advance.

GARE have discontinued many colours across their range of firing and non-firing products and we are selling these off at a discount of less 50%. Come 'n grab before they're all gone 'cause they're moving fast! There are some really great colours that can be played with to create a multitude of effects. The new GARE funstroke underglazes and pottery glazes are now in stock.

We have enlarged our range of stains and thus changed the names of a couple of them. All branches now have new sample boards showing both earthenware and stoneware fired samples. Should you wish to make your own coloured clay why not try incorporating these stains into the white firing clays such as white earthenware, Walford white stoneware or our porcelain bodies. This is easily done by just mixing some stain with water and kneading this into the plastic clay. There is no exact way of measuring the amount of colour needed but carrying out tests of coloured samples and keeping

# From Aafke in Somerset West Branch

The old Julian calendar year has flown into the new one so speedily, without a pause to catch one's breath, it feels as though the New Year has yet to begin. I'm working on starting a new year with the Chinese calendar – the year of the Pig – on 18 February 2007. With this year comes an exciting new cycle of workshops, run by Elsabe and Ralph Johnson. CPS Somerset West will also soon be the home to our new mould-making division.

Shape, texture and colour (or lack of one or all of these) are all incredibly important in expressing one's creativity. Colour, contrasted with itself, even on a flat surface, often has an immediate drawing power – with the result that underglaze, and glaze are instant attractions for those just starting out in the ceramic field. Equally powerful is the form of an object. This often gets forgotten during the thrill of making a piece, yet still carries more weight than texture. Texture is both form and colour. It is part of and enhances the shape, creates light and shadow, and offsets colour. It is often overlooked, as a powerful tool in it own right. A simple band of texture can hide a join in the clay as well as add finishing detail to a pot. For this reason (as inspired by Ian Garrett and The Sculptor's Bible by John Plowman) I aim this year to make textured samples of clay. I hope thereby to inspire sculptors and potters alike to try new avenues.

#### **HINTS & TIPS**

It is the hot time of the year again and pots dry out much faster, increasing the risk of cracking.

So be a little more patient and keep them covered longer. A good idea is to open pieces for short periods in the beginning and increase the time spent open as the day's progress and the piece dries out. This works very well on bigger pieces like sculptures.
